Consequences. There is a positive/negative consequence for all choices that we make. For example, I remind the class often "If you are safe you can sit with your friends at
the rug or cafeteria table. But if you are not being safe or making unsafe choices then you cannot sit with friends" This also goes for recess time, "If you play safely then friends will want to join you if you
